AGENDA: *Detailed agenda to be posted in October.* Venue will open at 7 AM and Opening Ceremonies will start at 8:30 AM. Event will conclude around 6 PM. (Workshops with Judges will be held before lunch.)

A WORD FROM THE SPONSORS: The Lone Star Regional and College Park HS have teamed up to bring more Houston Area teams an additional day to experience the thrills of a FIRST competition right here in Houston! This event will feature an official FIRST playing field, but will be limited to 36 teams to ensure that all teams get to play minimum of six Qualification Matches. This is a great opportunity for young teams to learn from veteran teams and for all teams new drivers to get experience in a competition environment in preparation for the 2013 FRC season.

Judges from the Lone Star Regional will also be on site to host training/Q&A sessions on the judge awards. Judges will provide an overview of the judge award process and tips on how to impress the judges. A special session will be dedicated to the Chairman's Award.

REBOUND RUMBLE!!!

- All Rules from the 2012 FIRST game Rebound Rumble will apply, except as noted below.
- Awards: Judge Awards will not be given. Instead, teams are invited to training sessions with LSR judges.
- Alliance Selection: Teams seeded 1-8 at the end of Qualification Rounds must pick alliance partners seeded 9 and below.
- Alliance Size: Teams will be picked for an alliance, with 4 teams per alliance. In the event an alliance has 4 teams, all teams must be allowed to play in the first two elimination rounds. After that, the Alliance Captain will decide which teams play in each round.

VENUE INFORMATION AND LOGISTICS:

- Pits: Pits will consist of tables only. No additional structures can be constructed/brought in. Decoration cannot be affixed to the walls or floor (or other permanent school structures).
- Robots: Teams are allowed to bring only one (1) robot.
- Practice Facilities: A practice goal will be provided. There will not be a practice field or practice matches.
- Tools: No machine shop on site. Only small tools will be allowed in pits.
- Safety: All Regional and venue safety rules apply (<http://frc-manual.usfirst.org/viewItem/6>). In addition, all teams must provide their own safety glasses.
- Food: No food or drink is allowed in the competition gym. Concessions will be available.
- All participants must sign a consent and release form.
